Business Time-of-Use Electric Rates

Help us establish a new rate option for business customers. Time-of-Use (TOU) rate structure more accurately reflects the cost of electricity and when you use it. TOU rates encourage you to use electricity when demand is lower and power is cheaper. Shifting your energy usage to offpeak hours will help you save money.

AU has a pilot program that allows businesses to view their on-peak and off-peak usage while providing data to determine future rate structures and costs. Customers must be on the General Service <25 Kw rate and have an AMI electric meter installed to be eligible. If you are interested in participating, email billing@austinutilities.com.



Energy-Saving Tip

Change your air filter regularly.

It is important to check your air filter every month, particularly during heavy usage periods such as winter and summer. If you notice that the filter looks dirty after a month, it is recommended that you change it. At the very least, the filter should be changed every 3 months or as per the manufacturer's instructions. A dirty filter can slow down the airflow resulting in the system working harder to keep you warm or cool, ultimately wasting energy. Moreover, a clean filter will prevent dust and dirt from accumulating in the system, which can lead to expensive maintenance or early system failure.
