WHAT IS A RAIN BARREL?

Rain barrels can be placed under a roof downspout to collect stormwater runoff that can be used for watering your lawn and gardens. This reduces runoff that carries pollutants into streams and rivers. Rain barrels:

- **Conserve water in the summer months**
- **Help lower water bills**
- **Reduce water pollution**
- **Help keep excess water out of the sewer system**
- **Are easy to install**

REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be a water customer of Austin, Owatonna, or Rochester Public Utilities.
- There is a limit of 5 rain barrel rebates per account.
- Rebate valid only for rain barrels that are least 40 gallons in size.
- Rain barrels purchased or installed before the start of this rebate are not eligible.
- If applicant builds own rain barrel(s), rebate may be used for materials. All receipts for materials, along with a picture of the rain barrel, must be submitted to receive a rebate.
- Copy of receipt(s) must be enclosed to be eligible for a rebate.
- Survey and application must be complete in their entirety to be eligible for a rebate.
- Applicant, if selected for random inspection, agrees to allow inspector access to the premises in order to verify installation.
- Due to limited funding, this rebate can be withdrawn at any time without notice.
- Rebates will not exceed the purchase price
- Applications will be processed on a first come, first served basis.
- All applications from the previous year's purchase must be received by March 31.
